These are all good ways to help us learn better online.</p>
<p><b>No distractions</b></p> <p style="text-align: right;">Zhang Penghui, 15, Heilongjiang</p> <p>Online learning needs strong self-control and willpower(意志力). There are lots of distractions(分心) while studying at home.</p> <p>My mom likes to offer me snacks and drinks, which sometimes distracts me from listening during my classes. I have asked her to stop entering my room while I'm studying. A quiet room and a clean desk can help me concentrate.</p>	<p><b>Focus on your studies</b></p> <p style="text-align: right;">Wang Ruixue, 14, Hebei</p> <p>The Internet is new to us children in the countryside. Many online games are very attractive to me, and they may take a lot of time away. I have used a timer(计时器) to record time spent on non-course websites and limit myself to five minutes at a time. When you feel yourself losing concentration, consider taking a short break, but make sure that the time you spend on your breaks won't take too much of your study.</p>



• **Ask yourself some important questions**

The most important question to ask yourself is why you want to learn a second language. The following chart shows some of the reasons.

Another question to ask yourself is how much time you're willing to spend on this.

• **Find the right partner**

Many websites have hundreds of partners to choose from in the language you want to learn. So how can you limit your search? The first thing you should know is that people who have been active and have a reason to learn the language are likely to be good partners. Another thing to keep in mind is that it is better to find two exchange partners. People lead a busy life, and one person can not be available(有空的) all the time.

• **Be clear about your expectations**

Once you find a partner, be clear about what your expectations are. Explain to the person how long you'd like the meetings to be and how often you'd like to meet.

• **Be prepared**

Before each meeting, prepare some questions on a topic of your choice. That will give you the chance to look up related (相关的) words as well as think about your own answers. Preparing topics ahead of time will also help you avoid having nothing to say at your meetings.

• **Don't be picky (挑剔的)**

You should keep in mind that during meetings the main goal is practising conversations. 因此,不要害怕犯错。And it's important to let your partner speak freely, even if he or she makes mistakes.

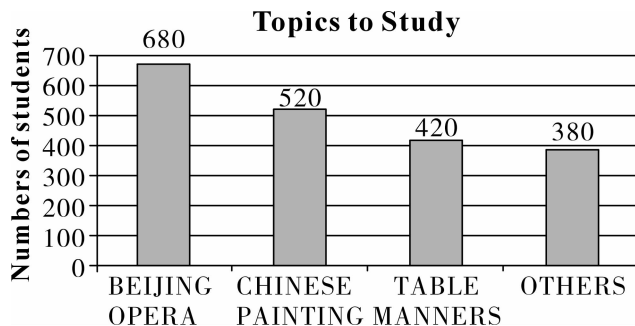
